Activity Name	Description	Group Size	Typical Duration
The Missenden Games	NEW FOR 2011: Tackle our 5 separate team challenges in this Olympic themed Event - tests a wide range of team skills (prizes for all participants)	Teams of 4-8	2 hours
Giant Connect 4 Scavenger Hunt	An outdoor treasure hunt, with two / three levels of problem solving - finding the treasure, solving the puzzles and then completing the Connect 4 grid.	2 teams, any size (max per team =20)	45 mins to 1 hour
CodeMaze	A scaled down (indoor) version of the above, without the Treasure Maps (yeah, really), but twice as difficult to complete - fiendish !	as above	30-45 mins
Team Drawing	Using the templates provided, one player describes a series of simple geometric shapes for their team to draw / replicate. Sounds easy, but is surprisingly tricky.	Ideal team size 6-8	30 mins
The Shepherd	Teams decide amongst themselves who should be the shepherd, sheepdog and sheep... and agree on how the shepherd's whistle should be used to direct the (blindfolded) sheep into the sheep pen.	Ideal team size 6-8	30 mins
Human Draughts	Participants become the draughts pieces and play in teams on a giant board. Fast moving and usually chaotic game.	2 teams of 6-12	30 mins
Runaround Quiz	A general knowledge quiz with a twist and a chance to mislead your opponents - based loosely on the popular 1980s Children TV programme of the same name.	Multiple teams (any numbers)	30 mins to 1 hour
4 Letter Word	A word game where teams work together to form 4 letter words using randomly chosen Scrabble tiles. Anyone whose letter isn't used drops out for the next round.	Multiple teams (any numbers)	30 mins
Colourblind	A logic puzzle asking teams to decipher the name of the organisation hidden within the confusing set of clues.	Teams of 4 or more	15-30 minutes
The Missenden Abbey Mystery	UPDATED FOR 2011... part treasure hunt, part whodunnit - piece together the clues hidden in the grounds of the Abbey to discover who stole the Abbot's sacred scrolls.	(Multiple) Teams of 3 or more	30 minutes, 45 minutes OR 1 hour versions available
Tower Build	... working as a team, use the crane provided to build a tower of blocks - the current record is 6 blocks	Groups between 4-24	15-45 mins
Pipeline	... a fantastic post-lunch energiser - transport the marble through the course and into the finish using only the limited pipeline resources	Teams of 4-8	15-45 mins

Activity Name	Description	Group Size	Typical Duration
The T Puzzle	... Simple. A 4 piece Jigsaw. Just make the letter T... no-one has solved this in less than 10 minutes so far !	Teams of 4-8	15-30 mins
Culture Shock	NEW FOR 2011 ... Compete against your colleagues to win casino chips by being first to grasp the rules of a brand new dice game... (this game has a big twist - not revealed here.. call for details!)	Groups of 12-24	30 mins
Great Missenden High Street Challenge (Roald Dahl Trail)	A Treasure Hunt using local landmarks and shops as clue sites. No local knowledge required !	Multiple Teams of 4-10	1-2 hours
The Bomb	A Belbin team game challenging participants to defuse the bomb before the countdown timer runs out... oh and you can't touch the bomb at any stage.	Teams of 4-8	30 mins
Team Write	A Belbin team game where the aim is to co-operate by manoeuvring a pen attached to 8 pieces of string. Team players have to listen and work together in order to draw an object.	Teams of 4-8	30 mins
Team Shape / Build	Another Belbin activity where each member is given a mosaic board with a limited number of incorrect pieces to complete the picture. Although initially working independently the aim is for all the team members to construct the shapes gaining the extra pieces from fellow players.	Teams of 4-8	45 mins
The Swamp (outdoor equipment)	Using 3 planks and one length of rope, the team must get themselves and all the equipment from one side of The Swamp to the other, without touching the floor and avoiding all obstacles.	Teams of 4-10	30 mins to 1 hour
Up and Over (outdoor equipment)	The team (armed with just ropes and a barrel) must find a way to cross the span of the wooden frame from its highest point down to its lowest point - without touching the ground at any stage.	Teams of 4-10	30 mins to 1 hour
Berlin Wall (outdoor equipment)	Using a barrel, a selection of crates and some varying lengths of rope, the team must scale the 'electrified' wall to reach safety.	Teams of 4-10	30 mins to 1 hour
Spiders Web (outdoor equipment)	The team must pass through the holes in the web without touching any part of it or disturbing the spider.	Groups of up to 25	30 mins
Missenden March (outdoor equipment)	The team must negotiate the obstacle course using the one very long set of wooden skis.	Teams of 4-8	30 mins
